Please remember this only applies to Key Workers & Vulnerable Children Defined As:

Health and social care This includes but is not limited, doctors, nurses, midwives, paramedics, social and other frontline health and social care staff including volunteers; the support and specialist staff required to maintain the UK's health and social care sector. Those working as

part of the health and social care supply chain including producers and distributors of medicines and personal protective equipment.

Education and childcare Nursery and teaching staff, social workers and those specialist education professionals who must remain active during the COVID-19 response to deliver this approach.

Key public services Those required to run the justice system, religious staff, charities and workers delivering key front-line services, those responsible for the management of the deceased, journalists and broadcasters who are providing public service broadcasting.

Local and national government Administrative occupations essential to the effective delivery of the COVID-19 response or delivering essential public services, including payment of benefits.

Food and other necessary goods Those involved in the production, processing, distribution, sale and delivery of food.

Public Safety and National Security Police and support staff, ministry of defence civilians, contractor and armed forces personnel, fire and rescue services including support staff, national crime agency staff, those maintaining border security, prison and probation staff and other national security roles.

Transport Those who will keep the air, water, road and rail passenger and freight transport modes operating.

Utilities, communication and financial services This includes essential financial services provision (including but not limited to workers in banks, building societies and financial market infrastructure), the oil, gas, electricity and water sectors, information technology and data infrastructure sector and primary industry supplies to continue during COVID-19 response, as well as key staff working in the civil nuclear, chemicals, telecommunications, postal service and delivery, payments providers and waste disposal sectors.

Vulnerable children Children who are supported by social care, those with safeguarding and welfare needs, including child in need plans, on child protection plans, 'looked after' children, young carers, disabled children and those with education, health and care (EHC) plans.

Pre-Schools/Nursery Fees
