

Dear Parents / Carers

Firstly, we hope everyone has remained safe and well during these challenging times.

Further to the UK Government's recent announcement regarding the potential and conditional re-opening of our Early Years settings on June 1st, we are now working tirelessly in line with the current COVID-19 guidelines to ensure the health and well-being of our children, families and staff for when we re-open.

Dependent on further guidance, it is now our aim to reopen nurseries and preschools to all children from June 1st although we may adopt a staggered opening approach and expect the settings to be a lot quieter than normal.

We can assure you that we are putting extensive measures in place to protect your child and adhere to the government guidelines but must emphasise that it is your choice when you send your child back into the setting. If you decide you do not wish for your child to return just yet, charges will only recommence if/when your child starts back with us.

At this point, in order to help us plan ahead, it is vital that we gather some information from you. To begin with we are asking you to confirm if you would like your child to return to nursery/preschool by completing the below survey.

If you do not complete this survey then your child's place will automatically be cancelled and no further charges will be applied.

Please note your funding, if applicable, will cease for this term at the end of the school academic year (mid July), unless your funding is stretched.

If you do choose for your child to return your sessions will remain as they were previously, and you will be charged in accordance to the sessions booked - please log into your iPAL account and check your booked sessions using the calendar feature.

By mid-next week, we will make further information available to you as we release our extensive re-opening action plan detailing how we will protect everyone in our care following government guidelines.
