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Frequently Asked Questions

Does the company have public liability insurance?

Rest assured all of our courses and activities are insured up to the sum of £5 million.

What forms/procedures do you have in place?

All of the company’s forms and procedures have been designed around strict rules set out by Ofsted. All procedures are available to see at each of our out of school clubs and holiday course venues.

Holiday courses – what does my child need to bring?

We advise you provide your child with weather appropriate clothing such as trainers, sun hat, sun cream, healthy snacks, a packed lunch and plenty of drinks (not fizzy). Breakfast and a light afternoon snack are provided.

What Sports Provision do you offer?

All of our sports coaches are fully qualified to deliver physical education within the school curriculum as well as various after school sports courses.

How do you cater for preschool age children requiring full wrap around care?

Children between the ages of 2 and 4 are welcome in our out of school clubs and are offered a range of stimulating, age appropriate activities in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) curriculum.

What happens if my child gets hurt during a course?

All of our staff are trained in paediatric first aid. In the event of an injury, we would assess the injury and, if it is minor, we will treat the child at the venue so they can continue to take part. At this point we would contact the parent to inform them of the accident and complete an accident form. In the event of a more serious injury we would take the child straight to hospital and contact the parents immediately.

Will my child be provided with breakfast and snack?

Breakfast is provided until 8.30am and consists of a selection of cereals, toast with butter and jam etc, fruit, juice, water and milk. During our after school club, children are provided with a light and healthy snack such as ham and cheese wraps, crumpets, pancakes, dips and raw vegetables and crackers. Food intolerances are catered for. Fruit and drinks are always available throughout the session.

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PPA Cover Provision

At S4YC we are highly experienced in providing PPA cover to primary schools. This enables a school to meet their PPA responsibilities whilst also ensuring that they are delivering a high standard of curriculum P.E. to their students at the same time.

We have an excellent track record in providing PPA cover to schools across the UK and strongly believe that not only do we assist schools from a timetable aspect but we also add great value to the quality of P.E. they provide. What It Involves

Our PPA cover system is simple and effective: a teacher/sports coach will attend the school at a scheduled time and deliver a P.E. lesson allowing the school to meet their PPA requirements. No teacher supervision on behalf of the school is required; we will supervise a full children handover to and from the class teacher.

The quality of our teachers and the subsequent lessons that they teach have been rated outstanding by Ofsted therefore you can be assured that not only are you providing your teaching staff with the PPA they require but you are also delivering excellent levels of P.E. to your students.

We will deliver a variety of subjects throughout the year. Sessions can be booked on any day, subject to availability.

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Frequently Asked Questions

Are your staff DBS checked?

Before anyone works for our company it is a mandatory requirement for them to complete a full Enhanced DBS check. All staff are then registered on the DBS Update Service or are required to undertake a new DBS check every three years.

How much does it cost?

A full days PPA is available from £120 per day dependant on how many days you book per week. Please contact us for a personalised quotation.

What scheme of work do you follow?

We can follow the school nominated scheme of work or we will use the UK's first fully interactive P.E. platform "iPEP".

What behaviour strategies do you follow during lessons?

To ensure consistency throughout the school, we work with schools on an individual basis, the P.E. teacher will follow the same behaviour policy as the school use on a day to day basis to establish continuity for the students.

How do you monitor your P.E. teachers?

To ensure our staff are delivering to an outstanding level, all P.E. teachers are monitored on an ongoing basis. This includes CPD training, lesson observations and performance management.

How do you deliver lessons for gifted and talented children?

All of our P.E. teachers deliver lessons on a three-tier ability basis; low, medium and high ability. By challenging children through ability we believe they will enjoy P.E. and develop skills more effectively.

Do we get the same coach every session?

When you sign up to our service we will provide the school with a designated P.E. teacher to work alongside the school's P.E. lead. The teacher we provide will remain the same week in, week out ensuring consistency throughout the sessions we deliver.

Can the P.E. teacher run before & after school clubs for us?

We encourage schools to use the P.E. teachers to run extra curricular activities around the PPA. Normally these sessions are parent paid, however we can arrange an hourly fee if the school fund the sessions.

What happens if a child gets hurt during a lesson?

All of our staff are trained in first aid. We would assess the injury and, if it is minor, we will treat the child during the lesson so they can continue to take part. Any accidents will be logged in the school's accident book and we would always follow the individual school's policies.

What is your policy on bullying?

Bullying is not tolerated during any of our activities. In the event of bullying taking place this will be reported immediately to the school both verbally and in writing.

Frequently Asked Questions

Are Your Staff DBS checked?

Before anyone works for our company it is a mandatory requirement for them to complete a full Enhanced DBS check. All staff are then registered on the DBS Update Service or are required to undertake a new DBS check every three years.

How much does it cost?

Parents can take advantage of the governments free funded hours scheme offering children free places throughout term time. Alongside this parents can also choose to pay for sessions. Prices start from as little as £3.50 per hour. Please contact us for further details.

What hours does the preschool operate?

We operate two daily three-hour sessions in the morning and afternoon. Alongside this we also offer a breakfast, lunch and afterschool club. Parents can access childcare from 7.45am-6.00pm if required.

What happens if my child gets hurt during a preschool session?

All of our staff are trained in first aid. We would assess the injury and, if it is minor we will treat the child at the venue so they can continue to take part. At this point we would contact the parent to inform them and complete an accident form. In the event of a more serious injury we would take the child straight to hospital and contact the parents immediately.

What is your policy on bullying?

We operate a very strict anti-bullying policy and bullying in any capacity will not be tolerated. Anyone found bullying will be asked to leave the preschool session and their parents will be contacted and told to collect the child immediately. If your child is experiencing difficulties, no matter how small, we would encourage you to contact us so we can resolve the matter.

Are the children expected to wear school uniform?

It is compulsory for 3-4 year old children to wear the same uniform as the school we are based within. For the 2-3 year old children uniform is optional.

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Out of School Sports Clubs

At S4YC we offer a wide variety of sports clubs for schools to choose from. The sports clubs are designed to be fun whilst also focusing on developing the key skills for the relevant sport and helping children to boost their fitness levels.

Our sports clubs are specially designed to enable schools to offer their students well organised, Ofsted approved extra-curricular sports activities without impacting on their current teaching staff.

All sessions are based around fun sports activities. We will sign children in and out, collate all payments and take care of all administration for the course. Children will receive a 'Well Done' certificate after the course has finished.

What Sports do you offer?

What It Involves

Our sports sessions will run for one hour per week before or after school. A minimum 10 week block can be booked at any time throughout the year. Schools can choose to run a 10 week club for all of the school or two six week blocks – a block for each key stage.

We encourage all children from reception class upwards to take part in our clubs – they are an excellent way of boosting fitness levels, improving confidence and encouraging children to expand their skills. Regardless of ability our clubs provide something for everyone.

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Are your staff DBS checked?

Before anyone works for our company it is a mandatory requirement for them to complete a full Enhanced DBS check. All staff are then registered on the DBS Update Service or are required to undertake a new DBS check every three years.

How much does it cost?

If the school fund the course through their PE Premium Funding, sessions cost from £30.00 per session. However in the majority of schools parents fund the sessions. These cost from £4.00 per session per child.

What is the school's responsibility in relation to the courses?

The club will be held on school grounds at an agreed time. The school will also be responsible for providing access for the sessions and allowing S4YC to hold an introductory assembly to create awareness and interest in the club.

Does the company have public liability insurance?

What forms/procedures do you have in place?

The company's forms and procedures have been designed around strict rules set down by Ofsted. All procedures are available for schools and parents to see at any time.

My child is very young and has never played sport before can they attend the course?

All courses are open to boys and girls age 4 – 12 years. It doesn't matter if your child has never played sport before or if they attend regular weekly sessions. We encourage development through fun and believe every child has the right to play sport.

What do the children need to bring?

We advise children attend the sessions with warm suitable clothing, trainers, waterproofs and a drink (not fizzy).
